# WHILE AT YOUR COMMUNITY COLLEGE

## EASY ADMISSION

Upon declaration of an Associate of Arts or an Associate of Science degree at Amarillo College, Clarendon College, or Frank Phillips College, you are eligible for admittance to West Texas A&M University.

## TRANSFER CHECKUPS

Early in your time at your community college, you will work directly with a WT adviser to select the straightest path to your goals. And we'll check in along the way, so you can be confident of a smooth transfer experience, fast path to degree and the lowest costs possible.

## FINANCIAL ADVISING

Through the Education Credit Union Buff\$mart program, WT financial advisers will be available to help you plan how to pay for college while minimizing your use of student loans. This way you not only have a plan but also peace of mind before you transfer.

## Checklist

- Apply** at [www.wtamu.edu/apply](http://www.wtamu.edu/apply). As part of Destination WT, the \$55 application fee will be waived.
- Transcripts** can be sent to the Admissions Office (WT Box 60907, Canyon, TX 79016) or go online to [www.wtamu.edu/admissions](http://www.wtamu.edu/admissions).
- Activate your account** at [www.wtamu.edu/activate](http://www.wtamu.edu/activate). You will need your WT ID number, last name and birth date. For issues with your account or logging in, call WT IT at 806-651-4357.
- Student Financial Services** encompasses Financial Aid and Scholarships. Contact them at 806-651-2055 or in Room 108 of Old Main. You can also go online to [www.wtamu.edu/financial-aid](http://www.wtamu.edu/financial-aid) or [www.wtamu.edu/scholarships](http://www.wtamu.edu/scholarships).
- Download DUO** (Dual Authentication App) is required in order to increase security. Download it on your phone to access your student accounts.
- Transfer Student Orientation** will be offered online. This step must be completed before you can be advised or register for classes. Learn more at [www.wtamu.edu/tso](http://www.wtamu.edu/tso).
- Advising and greenlighting appointments** must be made at Advising Services. To do so, call 806-651-5300. Destination WT student register through their Buff Advisor based on classification.
- Living in a residential hall** may be required if you are under 21. Residential Living can be contacted at 806-651-3000, or you can go online to apply for housing or file an exemption at [www.wtamu.edu/housing](http://www.wtamu.edu/housing).

# AFTER YOU TRANSFER

## SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarship, up to \$3,500, will be granted while funds are available. Simply submit your transcripts and complete the Financial Aid process. If you have 60 hours and a 3.5 GPA, your scholarship will be granted regardless of financial need. Earn admission to Phi Theta Kappa and receive a one-time \$500 scholarship. ## ADVANCE REGISTRATION

At WT you will enroll based on your earned classification (60+ hours classifies you as a junior) and that means you have the same opportunity as students already enrolled at the University.

## TRANSFER STUDENT HOUSING

Want to live on campus for the full university experience? If you wish, you will have the option of living on a residence hall floor with other transfer students who understand your path to WT.

## HOUSING DISCOUNT

When you live on campus for three semesters, you are eligible for a 50 percent discount on your fourth semester. Stay for a fifth and receive the same discount for the sixth semester.

## HONORS MEMBERSHIP

If you are inducted into the Phi Theta Kappa honor society at your community college, you will be eligible to enter the Attebury Honors Program at WT. The Attebury Honors Program provides a variety of learning experiences and special opportunities, including the option to live in Conner Hall, the University's honors residential hall.
