



Timely Warning Notice: Motor Vehicle Burglary

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act is a federal law that requires colleges and universities across the United States to disclose information about crime on and around their campuses. A requirement of this law is timely notification to the campus community of certain crimes in a manner that will aid in the prevention of similar crimes.

On Tuesday, February 8, 2023 the University Police Department (UPD) responded to a call on-campus for multiple motor vehicle burglaries. The burglaries were reported to have occurred at approximately 2 a.m. in parking zones 6, 16, and 31 of WT campus. Two suspects were arrested.

UPD and outside law enforcement are currently collaborating on the investigation.

While nothing is failsafe, here are some suggestions everyone may want to consider:

- Lock all doors and windows before leaving your vehicle.
- Ensure all locks are in proper working order.
- If you return to find an unexplained open/broken window or door – do not enter. Contact the Police.
- Do not touch or clean up until the police have inspected for evidence.
- Be a good neighbor. If you notice anything suspicious in your neighborhood, call 9-1-1 immediately.
